Add a badge on the chest.


Make Your Own Badge






Look carefully at the map of the Island of Egg below.




Write a letter



Muffin's feelings An empathy-based class activity

Read through the story and discuss these questions together.

- 1. On pages 12 and 13 Muffin is wondering about her feet. She thinks that the other new cadets might laugh at them. Find words to describe how Muffin is feeling. Was Dad right to suggest she should stand with one foot over the other? Mum says Dad's idea is silly. What do you think?
- 2. On pages 14 and 15, Muffin thinks she might not find a friend. How is she feeling? What would you say to Muffin to make her feel better?
- 3. On pages 46 and 47, Muffin is finding it hard to get to sleep. Why do you think she is finding it difficult?
- 4. On pages 44 and 45 Muffin gets lost in the burrows. How does she feel when she bumps into the older puffin?
- 5. On 47-53, all the new recruits listen to Kintyre telling a story. What is the story about? How did Muffin feel when the story was over?
- 6. Look at the picture on page 63 of silly flapping. How do you think the puffins feel when they are silly flapping?
- 7. On pages 70–77 the recruits are training on wobble boards.

 How does Muffin feel when she starts doing this activity and why do her feelings change?
- 8. On pages 84 and 85 Muffin remembers being lost. It felt like a chill worse than winter. What sort of feeling is this?
- 9. On pages 89–93 Muffin is on the cliffs in the dark and hears a noise down below. Why does she say "I have to do this"?
- 10. When is Muffin most happy? Talk about what makes you happy?
- 11. How did Muffin's story make you feel?
- 12. What was your favourite part of the book?
- 13. What do you think UNFLAPPABLE means? How has Muffin changed after her adventure?
