




Activity 1: Extract and Questions



7. False. Gorillas actually share 98% of their DNA with humans!


8. False. There are roughly 40 species of fish that can fly.

9. True. Whilst most live up to 250 years, it is believed some may live to 500.


10. True. Jonathan is the oldest known living land animal.

Synchronised swimming



Activity 6: Animal Playing Cards


Cut out the playing cards at the back of this pack and fill the blank cards with your own favourite animals.

Once you've finished, find a partner and take it in turns to choose different sporting events and pit the animals against each other.


