A PINE CONE

A BIRD FEATHER

Look for footprints or tracks made by animals' or birds' feet. Can you trace or draw them?

Spy a tiny creature crawling or flying around. Don't pick it up!

A SMOOTH ROCK

Find a rock that feels nice and smooth when you touch it. Put it in your pocket.

SOMETHING RED

Discover something in nature that's the colour red and take a photo of it.

A VARIETY OF LEAVES

Collect leaves from at least three different trees.

A CLOUD ANIMAL

Look up at the sky and find a cloud that looks like an animal. Show your adventure buddy.

WILDFLOWERS

Seek out a beautiful wildflower in bloom and then draw a picture of it.

A NATURE SOUND

Close your eyes, listen carefully and identify a sound from nature around you.
