Write a persuasive travel brochure to encourage an alien to visit Earth. Think about the positive points about the location that you will want to promote.


A travel brochure persuades the reader to visit that place and provides information about things to do, places to visit and other helpful advice.








YETI ENCOUNTER

- How you felt when it was over












Create your own YOGIBOGEYBOOK using the template. You can use it to write down all of the weird things that you notice as you go about your day-to-day life.




Fold your sheet in half both ways. There are lines on the booklet to help guide you.




Using scissors, carefully cut along the centre fold.




Push the sides together, closing the gap you have cut.



Lay your paper flat again and fold both of the short edges into the centre.




Fold the paper in half long ways, then pull the cut open.




Fold the pages round so the cover is at the front. If you want your book to be extra strong, glue the insides of the pages so it holds it's shape.












