Teacher Notes

This collaborative art project will enable you to create a vibrant hanging display based on *The Girl at the Front of the Class* by Onjali Q. Raúf.

Print out the different bird designs and give them to children to colour in a variety of bright colours. Finally, hang your class flock from a washing line or attach to a classroom display board to inject an explosion of welcoming colour into your room.



Bird Craft

Add the five birds to your role play area with our simple cut out craft!

Cut out the body and wings for each bird. Keep the body all as one piece and the wings all as one piece.

Fold the body in half along the centre line. Cut along the faint wing line, so you are cutting through both sides of the body at the same time.


If you want the birds to hang from the ceiling, take a sewing needle and thread and stitch the thread through two parts of the birds spine so it will hang flat (see photo to the right).


Glue the inside of the birds body before sticking both sides together.


Next, fold the wings in half along line 1. Glue the wings together, before folding along line 2.

Feed the wings through the hole on the birds body.


























